$\frac{1}{2}$ " comb for making fabric on tennis shoe

Brushes of choice depending on the size you are painting.

Miscellaneous Supplies

Water container. Stylus, tracing paper, transfer paper, palette paper, scissors, paper towel, scotch tape, permanent black ultra fine pen

Instructions:

Dark Pumpkin

Basecoat the pumpkin in Tangelo Orange. Float around the outside edge and divide the segments with Heritage Brick. Float the highlights with Bright Orange. Swipe here and there with Royal Fuchsia.

Light Pumpkin

Basecoat the pumpkin in Bright Orange. Float around the outside edge and divide the segments with Georgia Clay. Float the highlights with Lemon Yellow plus a touch of Bright Orange. Swipe here and there with Royal Fuchsia.

Both Brown Puppy

Basecoat the brown puppy in Light Cinnamon. Float the shadows dividing his body parts in Burnt Umber. Referring to the color picture for the directions of the strokes do the hair using the comb first in Honey Brown and then in Honey Brown plus a touch of Snow White. Using the same brush do his spots in Lamp Black. Basecoat his muzzle in Honey Brown. Float the shadows with Light Cinnamon and the highlights with Snow White plus a touch of Light Cinnamon. Basecoat his nose and dot his eyes (using the stylus for the eyes) all in Lamp Black. Dab highlights of Snow White.

Both Striped Kitties

Basecoat the kitties in Antique White. Float the shadows dividing his body parts in Honey Brown. Referring to the color picture for the directions of the strokes do the hair using the comb first in Buttermilk and then in Snow White. Using the same brush do her stripes in Lamp Black and then add little tiny touches of Bright Orange. Basecoat her whiskers, nose and dot her eyes (using the stylus for the eyes) all in Lamp Black. Dab highlights of Snow White.

Stems, Tendrils and Leaves

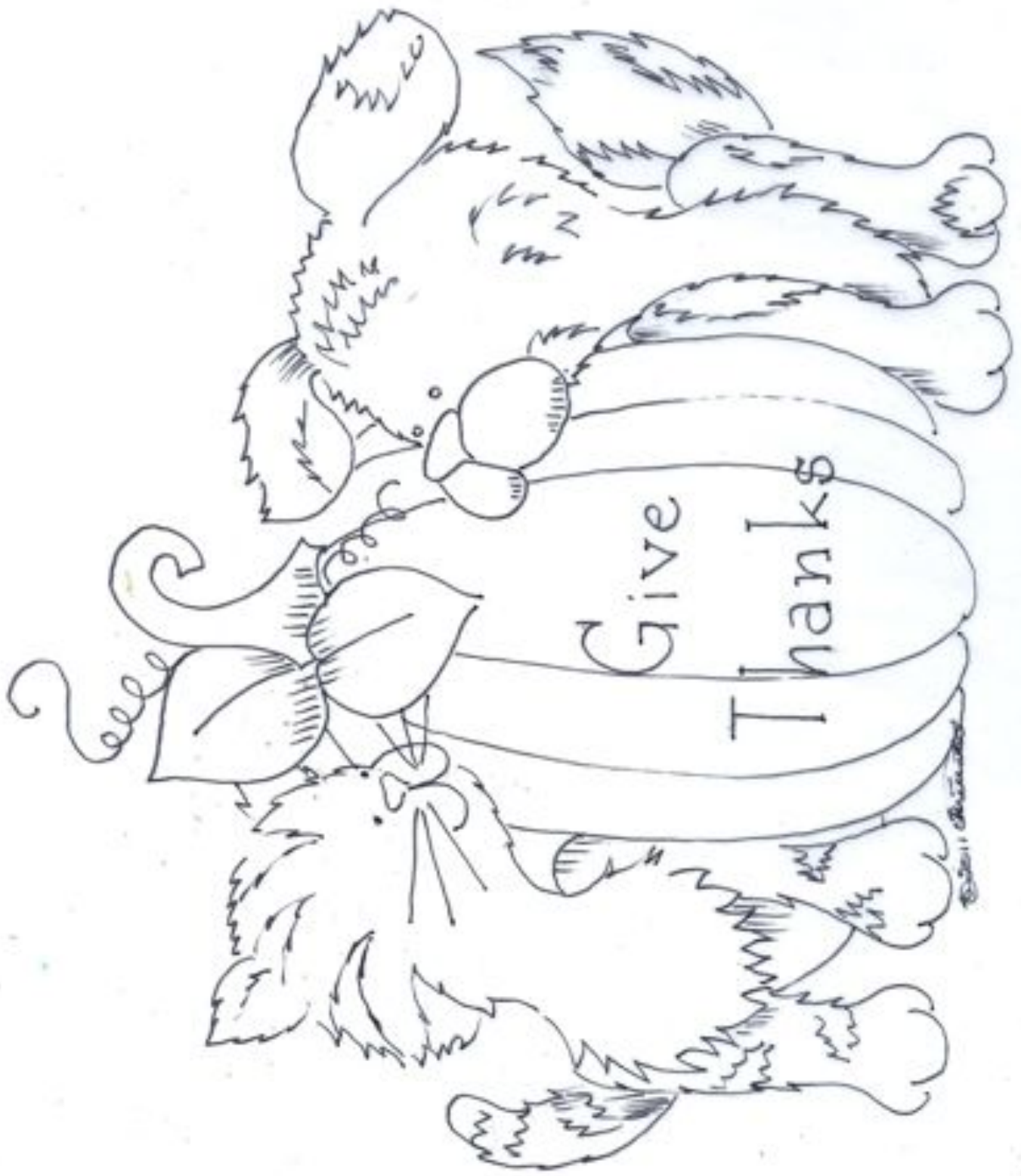
Basecoat the stems and leaves in Medium Hauser Green. Float the shadows with Plantation Pine and the highlights with Citron Green. Wash here and there with Bright Orange.

Lettering

Do the lettering in Burnt umber.

Using the black permanent pen do all of the line work.
